# 2008 CDJS Attendee Registration Agreement Rules and Regulations

JAM CAFE` POWER-LUNCH TICKET: As an attendee I have purchased a Jam Cafe' Power-Lunch ticket scheduled for Monday November 3rd and Tuesday November 4th between 11:00 a.m. - 1:30 p.m. Power Lunch tickets are only valid during scheduled days and are not exchangable or refundable. By checking this box I agree all terms and regulations of this 2008 CDJS Attendee Registration Agreement apply during this event, at all scheduled venues and during all free Westin transportation.

**NOTICE:** All Attendees and Exhibitors agree that as of a condition of attending the CDJS they will not engage either directly or indirectly in the activity of violating performance or any copyright laws. Anyone engaging in soliciting, promoting, selling or engaging in such activities during this event will be immediately removed from Summit and not allowed to return. Additional consequences of such activities include prohibition from attending future CDJS events and the possible revocation of CPSDJ/CPSME Certification or e-Ticket or Key-Club status with no refund or future consideration.

#### 1. General

This show is sponsored and managed by the CPSDJ/CPSME Certification Program and iJAM Productions. The words "CDJS Show Director" used herein shall mean the sponsors acting through their officers, the Computer Disc Jockey Summit Director, President, Chairman, or Summit Managers. All matters and questions not covered by the following rules and regulations or the Exhibitor Sponsorship Program are subject to the decision of CDJS Director. The General Information, Rules and Regulations may be amended or supplemented at any time by Summit Director, and all such amendments or addi-tions shall, upon reasonable notice, be as equally binding on all parties affected as the original General Information, Rules and Regulations.

#### 2. Hold Harmless and Insurance

Attendees assumes the entire responsibility and liability for losses. dam-ages and claims arising out of injury to Atendee's employees, agents or guests, or damage to Exhibitor's displays, equipment, and other property brought upon the premises of the Westin Atlanta Airport, Event Venues or during special event transportation. Attendees shall indem-nify and hold harmless the Westin Atlanta Airport, CPSDJ/CPSME Certification Program, iJAM Productions, CDJS Director and/or sponsored vendors, their agents and employees from losses, damages and claims inside, outside and travel to the event area that may arise as a result of actions or omissions of the Exhibitor, its employees or agents. The Westin Atlanta Airport, CPSDJ/CPSME Certification Program, iJAM Productions, CDJS Director and/or particapating vendors, will not be liable to the Attendee, agents or guests for any damages, loss or injury from fire, electricity, water, storm, riot, act of God, smoke, theft, accident or any other cause.

#### 3. Special Event Promotion

In the interest of making available a qualified group of vendors and supporting our sponsors during operation of CDJS events, the CDJS has contracted, on an exclusive basis, official sponsors to provide promotional representation. Vendors other than the designated sponsors will <u>MOT</u> be allowed to demo/rep/promote within any scheduled CDJS event area unless specifically authorized.

#### 4. Entire Agreement

This Attendee Agreement and all documents executed in connection herewith con-tain the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous oral agreements. No promise or agreement that is not expressed in this Agreement has been made by one party to the other and neither party is relying upon any other statement or repre-sentation of the other party, its employees or agents. Any addendum or modification must be in writing and signed.

#### 5. ADA Compliance

The Attendee understands that the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requires that areas must be accessible to persons with disabilities, and Exhibitor agreed in advance that it is solely responsible for assuring that its display complies with the ADA.

Exhibitors have hereby warranted that they will provide auxiliary aids and services to individuals with disabilities suitable for effective communication between all parties in accordance with the requirements of the ADA, so that the Exhibitor's display will be accessible, as defined in the ADA, to persons with disabilities. The Exhibitor's further warranted that where the provision of such auxiliary aids would fundamentally alter the nature of the goods and/or services provided by the Exhibitor, or would result in an undue burden to the Exhibitor, the Exhibitor will notify CDJS of that fact at least two weeks in advance of the summit and of the alternative measures it intends to take to assure compliance with the ADA during the period of the summit. The Attendee agrees to indemnify and hold CDJS Director and CPSDJ/CPSME Certification Program and iJAM Productions harmless for any claims arising out of or in connection with the Exhibitor's display's failure to comply with the ADA.

#### 6. Gifts, Contests, Food and Beverage

CDJS Director reserves the right to prohibit, limit or discontinue the distribution of gifts, give-aways or similar promotions. Contests, raffles and drawings, if permitted under state or local laws, will be subject to the approval of CDJS Director. There will be no announcement of Exhibitor's contests, drawings or raffle winners during the summit. All food and beverage items must be approved, and provided by the Wes facilities.

#### 7. Restrictions

CDJS Director reserves the right to restrict attendees that may have been falsely entered. This reservation applies to noise, persons, apparel, conduct, things, printed matter, or anything of a character that might be objectionable to the Summit as a whole. Attendees are specifically requlated not to disturb Seminars/Workshops. Children under the age of 8 are specifically pro-hibited from being on the Summit floor at any time. Age requirments may apply at special events.

#### 8. PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEO/RECORDING

NO exhibit, performance or event presented at the CDJS shall be photographed, videotaped, broadcast or recorded for commercial use, sale or distribution of any kind without the express written consent from CDJS Director. Attendees shall not photograph or videotape the exhibit/presentation or products during the 2006 CDJS. Attendee agrees to allow images of himself/herself captured during scheduled CDJS events to be used in any/all marketing freely.

#### 9. Inability To Perform

Should CDJS Director be prevented from holding the Summit, CDJS Director's liability to the Attendee shall be the refund of any payments for Summit-Pass-Only received. CDJS Director shall not be liable for any consequential damages which may arise from such cancellation. Should the Summit be canceled due to circumstances beyond the control of CDJS Director including, but not limited to, acts of God, acts of war, governmental emergency, labor strike or destruction of exhibit facility, CDJS Director has established a back-up date and location for re-scheduling. The CDJS Director shall have no further obligation or liability to the Atendee.

#### 10. Changes in Show Schedule

CDJS Director reserves the right to make appropriate changes in the event schedule at any time as it deems necessary for the overall success of the 2008 Computer DJ/VJ/KJ Summit.

#### 11. Violations of Rules and Regulations

Violations of these rules and regulations will afford CDJS Director the right to execute one or more of the following remedies:

1) The Attendee may be prohibited from attending the current year's

CDJS and will forfeit all Promotional payments;

2) The Attendee may be prohibited from attending the following year's CDJS or particapating in the entire program. The imposition of one or more of these remedies by CDJS Director shall not in any way limit available remedies provided in other provisions of contract or by law.

#### 12. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

This Agreement shall be interpreted and construed, and the legal relations created herein shall be determined, in accordance with the laws of the State of Georgia without reference to any conflicts of law principles that would require application of the laws of another state. The federal and state courts within Fayette County, Georgia shall have exclusive jurisdiction to adjudicate any dispute arising out of this Agreement. Each party hereto expressly consents to the personal juris-diction of, and venue in, such courts.

#### 13. SMOKING

The CDJS is a non-smoking event. Smoking is only permitted in designated areas outside the CDJS as designated by the Director.
